

**TOWN OF JEWETT
PARKING LAW**

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Jewett as follows:

ARTICLE I. No Parking

§ 1. Application of article.

The provisions of this article shall apply except when it is necessary to stop a vehicle to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or official traffic control device.

§ 2. Parking, stopping and standing prohibited at all times.

No person shall park, stop or stand a vehicle at any time upon any of the streets or parts thereof described in Schedule A, attached to and made a part of this chapter.

§ 3. Parking prohibited certain hours.

No person shall park a vehicle between the hours _____ of any day, unless otherwise indicated, upon any of the streets or parts of streets described in said schedule, attached to and made a part of this chapter.

ARTICLE II. Removal and Storage of Vehicles

§ 1. Authority to impound vehicles.

A. Emergencies.

When any vehicle is parked or abandoned on any highway or public parking lot within this town during a snowstorm, flood, fire or other public emergency which affects that portion of the public highway or parking lot upon which said vehicle is parked or abandoned, said vehicle may be removed by or under the direction of the Highway Superintendent.

B. Obstructing Traffic.

When any vehicle is found unattended on any highway or public parking lot within the town where said vehicle constitutes and obstruction to traffic, said vehicle may be removed by or under the direction of the Highway Superintendent.

C. Storage and charges.

After removal of any vehicle as provided in this article, the Highway Superintendent may store of cause such vehicle to be stored in a suitable place at the expense of the owner. Such owner or person in charge of the vehicle may redeem the same upon payment to the person with whom stored of the; amount of all expenses actually and necessarily incurred in effecting such removal and storage, such storage charges no to exceed \$50 per day or fraction thereof.

ARTICLE III. Miscellaneous Provisions.

§ 1. Penalties for offenses.

Every person convicted of a traffic infraction for a violation of any provision of this chapter which is not a violation of any provision of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York, shall, for a first conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$100 or by imprisonment for not more than 15 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment; for a second such conviction within 18 months thereafter, such person shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$200 or by imprisonment for not more than 45 days, or both such fine and imprisonment; upon a third or subsequent conviction within 18 months after the first conviction, such person shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$300 or by imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

ARTICLE IV. Effective Date

This Local Law shall take effect after it is filed as provided in Section 20 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
